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## NON-MEDICAL FLUOROSCOPES GENERAL SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Hand-held fluoroscopes shall not be used.
- 2. No part of the body may be inserted into the primary beam.
- 3. The control panel must be equipped with a key lock. Removing the key must not be possible when the key is in the "on" position.
- 4. A positive pressure switch must be provided to control the exposure, and switch must be located where the operator has a clear view of the radiation equipment.
- 5. Personnel dosimeters must be worn during operation of the equipment.
- 6. Any kind of accidental physical injury or radiation exposure must be reported to Radiation Safety Office immediately. Staff should report to Employee Health immediately for evaluation.
- 7. Any location changes, acquisition of new equipment, disposal or transfer must be approved by the Radiation Safety Office.
- 8. A copy of Georgia State X-Ray Regulations is available at the Radiation Safety Office.

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
