

## Hazardous Waste - SATELLITE ACCUMULATION AREA (SAA) GUIDELINES




- ALL CONTAINERS TO BE CLOSED.
- NEVER MORE THAN 55 GALLONS OF NON-ACUTE WASTES IN ONE SAA.
- NO MORE THAN 1 QUART ACUTE LIQUID WASTE OR 2.2 LBS. OF ACUTE SOLIDS. THIS INCLUDES DISCARDED CHEMICALS IN ORIGINAL PACKAGING.



- ALL CONTAINERS IN SECONDARY CONTAINMENT.
- ALL CONTAINERS IN GOOD CONDITION. NO LEAKS OR POOR CONTAINER INTEGRITY.
- ENSURE THERE ARE NO FREE LIQUIDS OR SPILLS IN THE AREA.



- AFFIX A HAZARDOUS WASTE LABEL TO THE CONTAINER, FILLED OUT COMPLETELY AND ACCURATELY. FOR SMALLER CONTAINERS (<1 LITER) AND IN THEIR ORIGINAL CONTAINER, LABEL "HAZARDOUS WASTE" ONLY.



- AFFIX THE CORRESPONDING GHS PICTOGRAMS TO THE CONTAINER.
- ANY UNIQUE HAZARDS PRESENT WITHIN YOUR LOCATION SHALL BE IDENTIFIED ON A SIGN POSTED AT OR NEAR THE ENTRY POINT OF THE SAA.
