


Cord Management Solutions

Improper cord management can present trip hazards leading to severe injuries. Below are some options to safely store cords.

- Remove any unnecessary cords and cables that are no longer needed.
- Invest in wireless computer accessories, if possible, to reduce the number of cords being managed at each workstation.
- Review and adjust the placement of equipment to minimize the length of cords running across the floor. Position equipment close to power sources and each other (as much as possible).
- Implement a cord management system to keep cords organized and off the floor. This can include using cord covers, cable trays, or hooks to secure cords, or overhead reels/mounts. **(See examples below)**
- Use reusable cable ties, zip-ties, braided/wire loom split cable sleeve, or similar, to group and hold cables together before placing in a cable management tray. Do not use duct tape or electrical tape.
- Mount power strips/surge protectors under desks, on walls, or place in cable trays (according to manufacturer instructions) for easy access.
